AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT OF MINOR

It is understood that this authorization and consent is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment, or hospital care being required but is given to provide authority on the part of aforesaid agent to give specific consent to any and all such diagnosis, treatment, or hospital care which a physician, meeting the requirements of the authorization, may in the exercise of his/her judgment, deem advisable.

I hereby authorize any hospital that has provided treatment to the above-named minor to surrender physical custody of such minor to the above-named agent upon the completion of treatment and discharge of said minor.

These authorizations shall remain in effect until revoked in writing to said agent.

Insurance Notice, Waiver of Liability and Disclaimer

I, the undersigned parent/guardian/legal custodian of _____, a minor, acknowledge that I am completely aware of the inherent risks associated with water polo and that participation in athletic events and/or a practice necessarily involves risk of physical injury. In consideration for accepting the registration of the above-named individual and permitting the voluntary participation of said individual in its programs, including without limitation, team practices, scrimmages, camps, tournaments and team activities, including travel to and from and accommodations in connection therewith (herein referenced as "MVP-Sanctioned Events"), I, jointly and severally, and intending to legally bind ourselves, our child and our respective guardians, heirs, executors, personal and legal representatives, estates, beneficiaries, administrators, successors and assigns (all of the foregoing collectively as "I" or "Us") hereby release, discharge, and hold harmless Miami Vice Polo, Inc. and Bruno Aquatics, along with all of their officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents and any other representatives (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses ("Claims") arising out of or relating to any physical injury, illness or damage that may result to said individual while participating in MVP-Sanctioned Events and further agree to indemnify and hold the Released Parties harmless against any and all such claims. I further state that I and/or my child takes full responsibility for any injury, illness or damage that may occur as a result of my child's participation, and that neither I nor my child will hold the Released Parties responsible for any aggravation of pre-existing injuries prior to or during my child's participation in MVP-Sanctioned Events.

I hereby knowingly and voluntarily waive, to the fullest extent permitted by law, the benefits of any statute, law, rule or common law, which may limit the scope of this Release and Waiver. In the event that this Release and Waiver is found to be invalid, unenforceable or void, in whole or in part, for any reason, then I acknowledge and agree that in no event shall the Released Parties' aggregate liability to any of us exceed any applicable limits of any insurance coverage maintained by any of the Released Parties. In no event shall Released Parties or any of them, be liable to any us for punitive damages or lost earnings, lost revenues or loss of consortium or companionship.

Athlete-Parent Code of Conduct

In order for the Miami Vice Polo Club to compete successfully at the highest level, it is essential to recognize that participation in our club is a commitment being made by entire families, not just players. Therefore, it is important that we outline our expectations for players and parents. Please read the following guidelines that we expect our players and parents to follow. All players and parents are required to sign at the bottom of the page and return this form in order for the player to be allowed to participate in any of the club's activities.

1. Players and parents need to understand that part of the mission of the coaches is to help the players develop into mature, responsible young men and women. Therefore, it is the responsibility of players to communicate directly with coaches when issues arise. If the issue remains unresolved after the player and coach speak, a parent may contact the coach. Please do not speak to the coach immediately before, during, or immediately after a game. If the issue is still unresolved after speaking with the coach, the parent may contact a member of the Board of Directors.
2. Parents are not coaches; the players should receive their directions only from the coaching staff on the pool deck, not from parents in the stands.
3. Players and parents should support the players on our teams and refrain from making disparaging remarks about or directed at any of our players, coaches, opponents, or officials. Parents must avoid any physical or verbal confrontations with the parents, coaches, and players of our club or our opponents or with the officials. No player or parent may post disparaging comments with respect to Miami Vice Polo, its players, its coaches, its opponents, or officials on any website, message board, blog, etc.
4. We understand that smoking, consumption of alcohol, use of drugs not prescribed by a physician, or other inappropriate behavior by either an athlete or a parent shall subject the player to immediate disciplinary action, including the possibility of expulsion from the team upon the recommendation of the head coach and/or the Board of Directors. Further, we understand and agree that being in the company of anyone engaging in such behavior shall be deemed participation in such behavior by the athlete and subjects the athlete to the same disciplinary action. All athletes staying in team or camp hotels agree to abide by all rules put into place by coaches, directors, and/or chaperones traveling with the team. Athletes are not to enter rooms where athletes of the opposite gender are staying, are to be in their respective rooms by the designated curfew time, and to represent Miami Vice Polo Club responsibly when traveling on behalf of Miami Vice Polo Club. These same rules apply to coaches and chaperones traveling on behalf of Miami Vice Polo Club.
5. Decisions about playing time, travel teams, and all other water polo related matters are made exclusively by the coaching staff and are not open to debate, discussion, or negotiation with parents. A player should feel free to discuss his/her status with the coaches at an appropriate time. Playing time and travel teams are not distributed on an equal basis and are not guaranteed by club membership.
6. No player will be allowed to participate in any practice or game unless he/she is registered with the club and with United States Water Polo. All club dues must be paid in full, and all medical releases, liability waivers, and codes of conduct must be fully completed and returned, in order for a player to be allowed to enter the water.
7. Unless otherwise arranged, players and parents are expected to provide their own transportation to all practices and games. As a general rule, players should arrive at games at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled time of the match. If you cannot be on time, be early!

By enrolling in the Miami Vice Polo Club and/or Miami Vice Polo Club-sanctioned events, we agree to follow these guidelines. We understand that failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in the removal of my son/daughter from the Miami Vice Polo Club and/or any sanctioned Miami Vice Polo Club events without refund.
